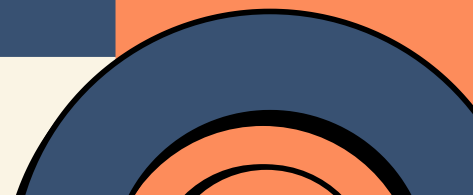

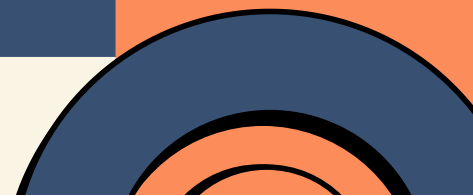



It is for social innovators and enterprise. It is for nonprofit leaders, staff of nonprofit organizations including CEOs and Executive Directors.

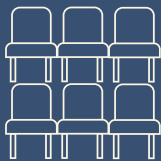
